



## **Location Weight / Volume Definitions and Control**

If required, the user may place the warehouse location under weight and/or volume control. If either weight or volume control is in force, the cumulative weight and volume found in each location will be maintained by the inventory transaction system. This data is not available for vendor or customer distributor locations.

Whether weight/volume control will be in use in the entity is controlled by the weight/volume code in the facilities parameters. The codes include

1. No location weight/volume data will be used in the entity.
2. Informational weight/volume control will be used in all locations. Informational weight/volume control means that if a location goes over its maximum weight or volume, the user will be notified but the transaction will not be stopped.
3. Specified location weight/volume control. The user will be able to indicate whether weight/volume control is to be used for a location when the location is being defined.
4. All locations will be under full weight/volume control. In this situation, if a location's maximum weight or volume is exceeded, the transaction that caused the excess to occur will be refused.

If available, the weight and volume data will be used in calculate freight loading.
